2. Additional Information

- Open-Xchange will discontinue support for Red Hat Enterprise Linux 5 and CentOS 5 with 6.22.1. As users of RHEL 5 and CentOS 5 we encourage you to update to the latest operating system versions.
- With the release of 6.22.1 Open-Xchange will also discontinue support for Windows Vista for OLOX 2.
- With this release Open-Xchange will support Internet Explorer 10

Changes of Configuration Files

Change #1120 - Need to specify AJP server socket's backlog value

Need to specify AJP server socket's backlog value. Some installations require a greater value than JVM's default setting (50). E.g. Apache's default is 128.

Therefore introduced new property in ajp.properties file: AJP_BACKLOG=0

Default is zero; meaning using JVM's default backlog setting.

Change #1125 - Configure to deny deletion of contact-collector folder

File 'contactcollector.properties' is enhanced by property 'com.openexchange.contactcollector.folder.deleteDenied'. Default is false.

Change #1141 - Added new MIME types

The following MIME types and file extensions are added to /opt/open-xchange/etc/mime.types:

application/font-woff woff text/cache-manifest appcache text/javascript js

To avoid ambiguities, the file extension 'js' is removed from the following MIME types:

application/javascript application/x-javascript

Side effects: auto-detection of e-mail attachments with above MIME types will use the updated assignments.

Change #1153 – Due to the introduction of the Open-Xchange Notifier a new configuration file oxnotifier.properties has been introduced

Change #1154 – Due to some refactoring concerning the Open-Xchange Updater server packages, oxtender2.properties has been changed

Four properties have been removed:

Change #1167 – Configuration parameter to scale contact images for vCards

Starting with 6.22.0, we decided to no longer resize contact images before writing them to the database, so that there could be a fair amount of bytes per image. For the web interface, our scaling service resizes them automatically when the image is requested.

There's currently no such logic before serializing image data to vCards, so that they could get potentially large, too. Therefore, a new configuration parameter will be introduced to scale images automatically before writing them to into vCards as follows:

- # Configures the maximum image dimension to use when serializing contacts to # vCards in the format [max_width]x[max_height]. Larger images will be resized
- # dynamically to fit the specified rectangular area. If left empty, images are # not resized at all and serialized as-is. com.openexchange.contact.scaleVCardImages=200x200

Change #1172 - Introduced 'mdns.properties' file

Introduced 'mdns.properties' file with property "com.openexchange.mdns.enabled" to enabled/disable MDNS bundle per configuration. Default is "true".

Change #1184 - Adapted log level for Hazelcast

Adapted log level for Hazelcast.

The following line is added to file-logging.properties.in, logging.properties: com.hazelcast.level=SEVERE

Change #1196 – Amount of data imported from ical can be limited

To limit resource usage, we introduced the property com.openexchange.import.ical.limit with a default of 10000 (-1 for unlimited) to restrict the amount of appointments/tasks/freebusy information imported in one go.



Change #1197 – UI plugin for provisioning the EAS phone has been renamed

The backend extension and UI plugin com.openexchange.mobile.config is renamed to com.openexchange.eas.provisioning. The old name clashes with some other names of backend bundles or frontend plugins which makes distinguishing the implementing features very difficult.

The components renamed here implement additional dialogues helping the end user to provision synchronization of their smart phones using the Exchange Active Sync (EAS) protocol.

All properties in the configuration file eas-provisioning-ui.properties are renamed from modules/com.openexchange.mobile.configuration.gui/* to modules/com.openexchange.eas.provisioning/*.

Change #1199 - Activate Hazelcast MBeans by default

Activate Hazelcast MBeans by default for debugging purpose via JMX console.

Hazelcast configuration file 'hazelcast.xml' is therefore enhanced by a properties> section.

Change #1203 - Changed default value for "com.openexchange.push.imapidle.debug"

Set property in push_imapidle.properties from true to false.

since commons logging is hard to configure, do it our own using LOG.info when debug is on here com.openexchange.push.imapidle.debug=false

Change #1206 - Drop hazelcast.xml, replace it by hazelcast.properties

Dropped hazelcast.xml, moved configuration to hazelcast.properties.

Change #732 – Introduced Open-Xchange mDNS bundle for remote look-up of Open-Xchange servers

Introduced Open-Xchange mDNS bundle for remote look-up of Open-Xchange servers. This is the basic bundle to support e.g. remote messages between Open-Xchange servers.

Change #1152 – Due to the introduction of the Open-Xchange Notifier a new package open-xchange-oxnotifier has been introduced

The Open-Xchange Notifier can be installed and updated via the Open-Xchange Updater. This caused the introduction of a new bundle:

com.openexchange.oxnotifier

and its associated package:

open-xchange-oxnotifier.



Change #1163 – Separated Parallels SpamAssassin integration into own package

Currently the spam solution for Parallels integration always uses SpamAssassin. It was not possible to use other spam solutions. Therefore the spam solution needs to be separated into its own bundle and package.

The new package is named open-xchange-spamhandler-parallels. The open-xchange-parallels package suggests this package because it previously contained the spam handler solution. Instead of installing open-xchange-spamhandler-parallels other spam handler implementations can be installed now.

Change #1182 - New packages for cluster discovery service

Introduced new packages for singleton cluster discovery service.

Exactly one cluster discovery service must be installed to use newly introduced Central Session Storage orderly (not delivered with 6.22.1).
