## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #2829.

#### 42118 Lookup to external PGP servers fails

When using cascaded "external" PGP servers as lookup and the requested key cannot be found on one of those, a error message has been thrown and presented to the user. This is now avoided by gracefully handling such cases and not returning and error but try the next configured lookup server, if any. Once the last server has been tried and did not provide a valid key, the fallback to Guest accounts is used. While regular PGP lookups and generic regression testing has been executed on this fix, a final test has to happen if the handling complies with the customer specific environment.

#### 3 Tests

Not all defects that got resolved could be reproduced within the OX QA lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported defect when deploying to a staging or production environment. Defects which have not been fully verified, are marked as such.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
