2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #2978.

43604 Unbranded guest reader interface shown

When accessing the Guard Guest Reader interface and having a custom theme enabled, the original theming was shown for a split second, after that the custom template was loaded. This has been changed in a way that the custom template gets loaded right away and no fragments of the original theming are shown.

43596 Error messages for corrupted database entries

In case incorrect provisioning happened, a follow-up error related to a users language was thrown. This is now resolved in a way that processing stops when detecting such corruption.

43109 Lockout period not reset on password reset

In case a guest user executed several unsuccessful login attempts, the account got locked for ten minutes. However, when resetting that users password, the lockout period was not cancelled. This has been fixed.

3 Tests

The Open-Xchange QA team has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
