2 Bugs Fixed since previous Public Patch Release

This document provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #1842.

30684 High CPU load after update to 7.4.1 and switch to Grizzly

USM not always removed enough old SyncStates when a new one is stored. Now USM make sure that computation which SyncStates need to be removed is performed completely before removing them (will automatically delete old SyncStates in DB if the limit was exceeded by previous USM versions)

30762 New appointments within Outlook show as new and did not get matched

A new calendar object with new uuid was created and upsynced after accepting an appointment.

If the underlying object update fails because of concurrent changes to the appointment from other participants, the USM will retry up to 10 times to get the newest state of the object from server and update it with the current client changes.

3 Tests

The OX QA team has successfully reproduced the reported issues and verified all bug fixes within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All bug fixes have been checked for potential side effects and changed behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
