## 1 Shipped Product and Version

Open-Xchange AppSuite backend 7.4.2-rev8

## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This document provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Release 7.4.2.

### **30138 Alternate Namespace IMAP capabilities get ignored after update and second restart**

The probe whether an IMAP server supports to create folders on root level was not thread-safe.

Solution description: Ensure each probe for root subfolder capability is exclusively performed.

### **30956 Configuration problems with external accounts (web.de and gmx.de) in Appsuite**

An auto-configured mail/transport account pair has no credentials set for transport server.

Solution description: Assume the credentials from mail server for transport server, too.

### **31010 Login breaks for single user with error message about severe error in loading user settings**

For some JSON data the written bytes into appropriate DB BLOB yields invalid data.

Solution description: More robust writing of JSON data BLOB to database.

### **31039 IMAP deletion issue with Cyrus 2.4.17 (content is left behind on disk)**

Inefficient way to move an IMAP folder below Trash folder.

Solution description: Perform a move to trash through a RENAME command on associated IMAP folder.

### **31086 USS-0004 Server regression by using custom contextSets and plugins**

Attempt to save non-existent setting into config tree floods the log files.

Solution description: Ignore failed attempt to save non-existent setting.

## 3 Tests

Not all issues that got resolved with this Patch Release could be reproduced within the OX QA lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported issue when deploying to a staging or production environment.



To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All bug fixes have been checked for potential side effects and changed behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
