2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #5147.

62281 Appointment time incorrectly displayed in Japanese

The Moment and moment-interval framework used inconsistent time formats in Japanese. Update locales in moment-interval plugin to be consistent.

62666 Error message "Unable to save draft, due to exceeded quota." even quota is not reached

The causing exception was hidden, which has been changed to find the root cause of this bug.

63404 high CPU load, login timeouts, note was not reacting anymore

Unnecessary/excessive locking in both - session management and general cache - leads to many threads trying to acquire the same locks. Improved session management and general cache implementation to use higher level concurrency classes and getting rid off unnecessary/excessive locking.

63675 clicking on direct link in appointment invitation results in "Error Cannot fetch folder with undefined id"

Late fetch of emoji library and replacement of emojis required dom-replacement after the deep-link has been registered which will remove any registered data. Fixed by loading emojis early to prevent asynchronous replacement of emojis.

3 Tests

Not all defects that got resolved could be reproduced within the lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported defect when deploying to a staging or production environment. Defects which have not been fully verified, are marked as such.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
