## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #5717.

### **MWB-311 Possible memory leak in middleware**

Internal cache in IMAP bundle used to hold in-memory structure of IMAP server's LIST/LSUB output steadily fills up over several months as long as enough active session are present. Moreover, accumulation of unused/stale IMAP store containers managed in IMAP connection cache also due to vast number of active sessions.

Let cached entries expire (and remove from cache) after reasonable amount of idle time as well as drop unused/stale IMAP store containers managed in IMAP connection cache to solve this issue.

### **OXUIB-279 Save distribution list from schedule view contains different contacts than expected**

User\_id was used as contact\_id.

This has been fixed by using correct contact\_id

## 3 Tests

Open-Xchange has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
