2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This document provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #2626.

40967 Private key could get overwritten

In a scenario where a user has multiple private keys and inadvertently created a additional key by replying to a mail sent to an alias address, it was possible that the primary private key got overwritten by a key for the alias address. This potential issue has been solved and a couple of failsafes have been added for hardening. Versioning for multiple keys has been re-worked to make sure each key has a unique and incremental version. In addition, only one key can now be marked as "current" and updates to the key list have been enhanced by a double-check to make sure the updated Key-ID is the correct one.

3 Tests

The Open-Xchange QA team has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
