2 Bugs fixed with this Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Release 2.1.0. Some of the announced bug fixes may have already been fixed at the existing code-base via Patch Releases.

OMF-660 OMF may not realize when a database export fails

Status: Fixed

Root Cause Description:

Missing support for CHAR type and no single indication on client side what didn't work.

Solution Description:

Return error message JSON object of what went wrong in case of unsupported MYSQL type in export and log it on the worker and return it in the batch response. Added support for MYSQL CHAR type.

Severity: 3 Components: Source, Worker Database Affected Packages: open-xchange-omf-target open-xchange-omf-worker

OMF-661 Provisioned taxonomy is wiped from the context during cutover

Status: Fixed

Root Cause Description:

All table rows on target are wiped out before the data is transferred from the worker. This will also wipe rows added during pre-provisioning which is not what is wanted in every case.

Solution Description:

Introduce a configurable behavior in what to wipe and what not.

Severity: 3 Components: Target Affected Packages: open-xchange-omf-target open-xchange-omf-worker

OMF-668 Mail filter migration may conflict with mail migration

Status: Fixed

Root Cause Description:

Mail filter migration may run at the same time as mail sync.

Solution Description:

Make mail filter migration wait on mail sync.

Severity: 3 Components: Worker General Affected Packages: open-xchange-omf-worker

4 Tests

Not all defects that got resolved could be reproduced within the lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported defect when deploying to a staging or production environment. Defects which have not been fully verified, are marked as such.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
