2 Bugs fixed with this Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Release 2.1.0. Some of the announced bug fixes may have already been fixed at the existing code-base via Patch Releases.

OMF-692 Classes of service are set after calling the migration status API

During cutover, set the classes of service in the Target LDAP before calling the Migration Status API (with SUCCESS) to avoid overwriting any changes performed by the Migration Status API through the Provisioning API.

Status: Fixed

Root Cause Description:

The {{oxCosDN}} LDAP attribute on {{oxCloudUser}} is currently set at the same time as the oxDeliveryStatus attribute to optimize performance since it doesn't require making two passes at the LDAP tree (both for querying the {{oxCloudUser}} entries and for modifying the attribute(s)).

Solution Description:

Separate the operation into two distinct ones (one to set the {{oxCosDN}}, which happens before the invocation of the Migration Status API ({{SUCCESS}}), and one to set the {{oxDeliveryStatus}}). Save the LDAP {{oxCloudUser}} lookups from the first into a cache to speed up the second.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
