2 General information

The main focus for this release of OX Drive for Windows 1.4.6 is the support for multiple accounts, improved Windows Explorer integration and support for proxy servers.

3 Bugs fixed with this Release

This document provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Release 1.2.2. Some of the announced bugfixes may have already been fixed at the existing code-base via Patch Releases.

33560 High system load when synchronising many files

When having ten-thousands of files in sync and changing a couple of them afterwards, the client system load spiked. This was caused by rather inefficient local database queries that avoided using database indices. Also, some unnecessary database queries have been executed which led to a good amount of load when dealing with many files. Both issues have been resolved and system resource requirements at the client have gone down significantly.

4 Tests

The Open-Xchange QA team has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
