2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #2825.

42113 Huge images stall Outlook synchronization

In case a image gets synchronized with Outlook that's too large to be processed by the OX middle-ware, the sync stalls since the API responds with unexpected error codes. Those error codes have now been implemented in USM to enable compatibility again.

35198 High CPU load caused by HTML processing

A set of regular expressions is used to process HTML content, for example E-Mail data. A specific regex did replace `body` tags with `div` tags and could run for a login time while consuming CPU resources. This has been solved by optimizing the specific regex. This defect is also tracked as Bug #41798.

3 Tests

The Open-Xchange QA team has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
