# 3. Bugs fixed with this PTF Release

- 14177 missing common shell functions file on update from RC3 to RC4Fix: Another fix for the new UCS detection.No potential side effects.
- 14178 user management broken when using non ascii chars in user names Fix: Additionally to the checks on the database if some name already exists a check in software is added with String.equals(). This method is able to detect differences like umlauts or accents. Additionally the database must be changed to distinguish those different login names. The column uid of table login2user must be changed by using now the collation utf8\_bin instead of utf8\_unicode\_ci. This update task should run quickly because only the collation is changed.

  No potential side effects.
- 14207 wrong exit code from init script if you stop an already stopped service Fix: stop function to return 0 instead of 7 to be LSB compliant. No potential side effects.
- "Mail account is not a number:" after Update to 6.10
  Fix: Using static delimiter character '/' to separate mail account part form fullname part within a mail folder identifier. Thus mail folder prefix contained in full identifier follows the same pattern and is easy to detect.
  - No potential side effects.
- 14232 Answering mails and saving them as draft will remove original from Inbox

Fix: Checking if user is working in his default "Drafts" folder prior to deleting referenced mail.

No potential side effects.
