1. About this Release

The OXtender for Mobile Web lets you access (read only at the moment) data from Open-Xchange Server with your iPhone or other internet enabled devices. Data of the following modules can be accessed:

- Calendar
- Contacts
- Tasks

2. Shipped Packages and Version

2.1. OXtender for Mobile Web - Release Candidate 1

File name: open-xchange-gui-mobile_1.0.0-2_all.deb open-xchange-gui-mobile-1.0.0-2.1.noarch.rpm

Requirements:

- Debian Lenny or Etch, SUSE Linux Enterprise 10
- Apache2
- PHP5 with the following modules
 - gettext, json, mcrypt, curl
- System-Locales 'de_DE', 'en_EN', 'es_ES', 'fr_FR' and 'nl_NL' (UTF8)



3. Features

- Special AJAX/DHTML frontend with easy-to-use navigation for devices having a Webkit supported browser installed (e.g. Iphone or Android based devices)
- Standard HTML frontend for devices with a regular browser
- Automatic device detection and redirect to the optimal browser frontend
- Login credentials can be stored within a cookie
- AJAX UI: Screen rotation and resizing supported (tested on Iphone)
- Calendar list showing all appointments from all calendar
- Detailed appointment view
- Contacts list showing all contacts from your private folder
- Detailed contact view
 - Additionally support of (tested only on Iphone):
 - Clicking on phone numbers automatically dials the number
 - Clicking on an address opens the location at google maps
- Tasks list showing all tasks from your private folder
- Detailed task view



4. Known Issues

4.1. Limitations of this Version

Graphics Settings

Depending on your browser and your browser settings you may not be able to see graphics. Since buttons for switching between the OX modules are implemented as graphics, you may not see these menu buttons. Workaround: Please make sure to activate graphics in your browser settings. In a future release labels will be shown in addition to graphics to make those buttons visible no matter what settings have been chosen.

General / System

Due to a bug in PHP version $\leq 5.2.0-8$ dates may be displayed wrong. This does not happen with PHP version $\geq 5.2.6$. We are still searching for a work-around.
