Outlook OXtender Themability

For corporate identity reasons you might want to change the appearance of your Outlook Oxtender. This is easily achieved. You only need to install your .msi file and can then replace the respective entries and images.

Registry entries for themeability

After installing the OXtender for Microsoft Outlook you find the following registry entries under `HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\OPEN-XCHANGE\OXlook`:

productname	Name of the product, name of the menu entry
companyname	Name of the company selling the product
productid	Abbreviation or id for the company/product.
productnamenotifier	Name of the notifier

Just replace the entries by your own ones. If you then e. g. right click on a tab your own company id will be shown.

In order to change the folder names (OX System Folder, OX Global Addressbook, OX Public Folders and OX Shared Folder), use an MSI editor to change the PREFIX value in the property table. As an alternative you can set a value for the PREFIX parameter when starting the MSI (`OXtender_for_Microsoft_Outlook_German_6.11.0.msi /PREFIX=MyCompany`).

Example: To change OX Public Folders into MyCompany public folders replace OX with MyCompany. The PREFIX is then saved to `HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\OPEN-XCHANGE\OXlook`.

You probably also might want to replace some icons, the logo and the background of the splashscreen. This can be done with MSI editors like Wise.

Following images can be replaced:

error.ico	red logo that indicates a warning
push.ico	green logo that indicates updates via push mode
pull.ico	gray logo that indicates updates via pull mode
	It is visible in the tray bar and in the toolbar.
splashmain.jpg	splashscreen background
splash.jpg	company logo

Plug-ins can be activated or deactivated for single users. To deactivate a plug-in, create the registry key `HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\open-xchange\oxlook\plugins` and set the key (DWORD) "Pluginname" = 2

To activate the plug-in, set the key to 1.
