1 General Information

Wforce Package - Improvements

- Now builds a separate luajit package ('wforce-lua-dist'), based on the openresty luajit fork. This is to address some issues found with stock luajit. The package also includes some lua modules that wforce typically makes use of.
- Build the wforce-minimal image for both arm64 and amd64, and add provenance.
- Fix Centos v7 & Centos v7 EOL builds to still work after Centos v7 went EOL
- Add support for Debian Bookworm, remove support for Debian Buster

Wforce-Policy Package - Changes

- Remove Lua modules from packages as they are now part of the wforce-lua-list package
- Continue to support Centos v7 builds after Centos v7 EOL
- Support debian-bookworm and drop support for debian-buster. Completely refactor debian packaging.
- Use new wforce-minimal image as the basis for wforce-policy image
- Build multi-platform wforce image (amd64 and arm64), add provenance, sbom and sign image

Replfwd Package - Improvements

- Support building Debian Bookworm Packages
- Drop support for building Debian Buster Packages
- Build the replfwd image for multiple platforms (amd64, arm64) and add provenance
- Use alpine-based image for greatly reduced image size and improved security

Cloud Control - Improvements

- Enable webserver tls and password to be specified via an external secret
- Tested on Kubernetes 1.28 through 1.30
- Use wforce and replfwd images based on alpine, which are much smaller and more secure

Cloud Control - Bug Fixes

- Fix regex in readiness check for wforce containers
- wforce.conf: Better error checking for v6 interface existence
