1 General Information

OX Display is an Open-Xchange product that works in conjunction with the OX App Suite user interface (UI). It provides an additional monetization layer by selectively displaying adverts directly in OX App Suite.

As our customers have differing requirements for advertising, OX Display is fully configurable/customizable. Simple JSON based configurations can be created to specify exactly how and where adverts are to be displayed. There is no direct coding within OX App Suite making it very safe. These configurations can then be applied to individual users or groups of users alike. This process can even be automated or linked with the provisioning system.

OX Display works with the OX App Suite UI to show advertising in all core apps (OX Mail, OX Contacts, OX Calendar, OX Tasks, OX Portal, OX Documents and OX Drive). It includes features such as reload timers, trigger, show & hide functions as well as segmentations related to which user should see what ads and in which modules.

OX Display supports all standard ad formats in all types of devices (Smartphone, Tablet and PC). By default, the framework detects the device characteristics and adjusts the ad space accordingly. If the screen size is too small, then it simply does not show the ad.

This new release provides the following enhancements:

- Ad Tracker to monitor performance and ensure technical functionality

Requirements: To use OX Display v1.3.1 you need to be running OX App Suite v7.8.4.
