## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #6181.

### **PLG-415 UI crashes when trying to remove blocked senders address from blocked senders list**

Rendering logic not optimized for long lists. At each entry deletion, the update of the list event triggered a render for each of the elements of the list.

This has been solved by improving the rendering logic by listening to the 'reset' event, which is triggered by backbone collection after the collection is reset with new entries. This will trigger a single render instead of a render for each element of the list.

## 3 Tests

Not all defects that got resolved could be reproduced within the lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported defect when deploying to a staging or production environment. Defects which have not been fully verified, are marked as such.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
