2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #4868.

60188 Missing epoch in Debian open-xchange-oxaas 1.6.4 packages

Lost debian epoch prevent update of open-xchange-oxaas packages since 1.6.4. Updates from 1.6.3 to 1.6.4 requires manual updates of open-xchange-oxaas packages. This change align this behaviour also to rpm base distros.

CP-83 createreport stops with "Unable to write into file:" but file is partially written

Check if Cassandra quota is present before converting it to a primitive type to prevent a NullPointerException

CP-84 Quota values form createreport are inconsistent and not plausible

Combine drive metrics and mail metrics if present to represent the unified quota

CP-85 Createreport of large single brand stops after around 10%

Alias modification may end up on different nodes when tarent adapter is used, which may lead to inconsistent data being handled. This has been fixed by either using the tarent adapter or local provisioning and invalidating the alias caches prior fetching the current list while doing updates.

3 Tests

Not all defects that got resolved could be reproduced within the lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported defect when deploying to a staging or production environment. Defects which have not been fully verified, are marked as such.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
