## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bugfixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #2767.

### **40362 EAS mail app: image not displayed on some devices**

Wrong order of collectionId and serverId in ItemOperations-Fetch response resulted in images could not be displayed on some mobile devices using EAS.

Now writing out correct order, so images are displayed.

### **41018 Password change not possible for external accounts after user password change**

An unnecessary validation with the old password was requested.

Validation is now skipped if only the password has been changed.

## 3 Tests

Not all defects that got resolved could be reproduced within the OX QA lab. Therefore, we advise guided and close monitoring of the reported defect when deploying to a staging or production environment. Defects which have not been fully verified, are marked as such.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server setup for system and integration testing.

All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
