## 2 Bugs fixed since previous Public Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Patch Release #4844.

#### 59903 Guard sign/encrypt default settings are honored even if user doesn't have guardmail capabilities

If a user has set up a Guard account and has configuration settings for default signing or default encryption, and then the account is disabled (capability.guard-mail=false), these defaults are still honored.

This has been solved by loading default settings even if guard-mail capability was removed.

## 3 Tests

Open-Xchange has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment.

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
