1 General Information

OX Guard v2.10.4 for OX App Suite v7.10.4

With this new release, Open-Xchange integrates OX Guard even more closely with OX App Suite v7.10.4. Enhancements to OX Guard in this release include:

- **New Mailfilter Rules for PGP Emails**
In combination with the new OX App Suite v7.10.4, users are now able to create rules to encrypt certain incoming emails automatically. Additionally, it is possible to create rules based upon PGP signatures as emails arrive.
- **Improved Handling of Decrypted Messages**
With a newly introduced user option, decrypted messages can be automatically re-encrypted when another email is selected, or if the user moves to another application such as calendar or contacts.
- **Improved Elliptical Curve Support**
Elliptical curve support for PGP encryption and signatures are greatly enhanced in this release.
