This package is a library that provides various utilities for implementing customizations.

Version: 1.3.1-2

Type: OX Middleware Plugin

Depends on:

```
open-xchange-core (<<7.10.3)
open-xchange-core (>=7.10.0)
```

2.1.1 Installation

Install on OX middleware nodes with package installer apt-get, zypper or yum:

```
<package installer> install open-xchange-util-custom
```
