2 Bugs fixed with this Release

This section provides a summary of bug fixes and changes that have been applied subsequently to shipping Release 1.0.8. Some of the announced bug fixes may have already been fixed at the existing code-base via Patch Releases.

58781 [L3] java.util.ArrayList cannot be cast to java.lang.String

Added fallback to also allow arrays of strings for Message-ID header.

58782 [L3] No enum constant matches value: 50

The Mobile API Facade now handles undefined values of the X-Priority header.

58899 Fix conffiles on Debian

mobile-api-facade-config.yml and rmi.properties are not marked as conffile on Debian-based distributions

58890 Conflicting default JMX Ports for IC and Facade

Changed default JMX port from 9997 to 9995 to avoid conflicts with image converter component

3 Changes relevant for Operators

3.1 Changes of Behavior

Change #OMFACADE-451 Handle non-reachable middelware as 504

The Mobile API Facade now implements a connect timeout of 10000 milliseconds. When connects fail in this time the facade returns a response with status code 504 Gateway timeout.

Change #OMFACADE-452 Return HTTP code 400 for arrays with expected values being empty Request which include an array of data, e.g. a list of mail IDs now return a 400 when the array is empty. This is used for endpoints like 'Move mails' or 'Delete mails'.

Change #OMFACADE-454 Forward Host header to middleware

HTTP headers 'Host' and 'X-Host' are now forwarded to the middleware. This is needed when the middleware has to do things based on these values, like authentication.

Change #OMFACADE-457 Allow blocking of standard OX Mail client

We introduced a configuration property to be able to block the standard OX Mail v2 client.

4 Changes relevant for Developers

4.1 Changes of external APIs

Change #OMFACADE-462 Capability for multiple accounts handling

The Mobile API Facade now returns the 'facade_accounts_sync' capability.



5 Tests

Open-Xchange has successfully verified all bug fixes that could be reproduced within a lab environment

To avoid side effects, the shipped packages have gone through automated regression test on both, a Continuous Integration System and a dedicated server set-up for system and integration testing. All changes have been checked for potential side-effects and effect on behavior. Unless explicitly stated within this document, we do not expect any side-effects.
